



## ***Kingston and Arthur's Vale Historic Area (KAVHA) - A heritage place worth looking after***

The Norfolk Island Government and KAVHA Board have decided to update the Conservation Management Plan for KAVHA. Some members of the planning team will be on Norfolk Island from 29 September to 8 October to start work, including the consultation process.

We want to know more about the reasons why KAVHA is a special place for the Island's communities so that these are recognised in the Conservation Management Plan and heritage listings. During this period, we will also provide some information about the possible future National Heritage Listing of KAVHA and the processes associated with the development of the nomination to the World Heritage List.

The planning team is interested to meet and talk with as many people as possible and is putting together a schedule of meetings and other events to make it easy for everyone to have a say. To start things off, you'll find us at Norfolk Mall on Saturday morning (30<sup>th</sup> September) and at the market by the post office the next morning - you can pick up some more information there.

The schedule will be outlined in *The Norfolk Islander* next week.
