#### **Portable floodlights purchased for emergency and community use**

Finance Minister Neville Christian has announced the purchase of two sets of powerful portable floodlights, previously used during the upgrade of Norfolk Island Airport.

Mr Christian said that the Electricity Undertaking purchased one set for \$32,000 from Coates Hire who previously owned the lights. The Touch Football Club and Norfolk Island Police donated \$10,000 towards the cost of the second set of lights, with the remainder being contributed by the Airport Enterprise. "I am very pleased that community organisations and the government have been able to work together to purchase these important community assets", Mr Christian said.

The Minister said that the floodlights will be of great value in emergency situations and for public events. The lights will also be made available for use by groups and community members on a cost recovery basis.
